




CITY OF RIZE

Rize is a natural harbour in the north eastern Anatolia, where the blue sky,Black Sea and foggy peaks hug each other. The very name 'Rize' is known, throughout Turkey, for high quality tea production. Home to many tea plantations, former empires, the ancient Greeks, Byzantine and the Seljuk Turks, each contributing to Rize's rich culture in food, textiles and language. Rize is in the Northeast Anatolia circled by Trabzon (41 miles [66 km]), in the west, Bayburt and Erzurum in the South, Artvin (55 miles [88 km] in the East ,on the Georgian

border, and Black Sea in the North. The nearest airports are in Trabzon (41 miles [66 km] west) and in Batumi (60 miles [100 km] east).

a. Weather

Rize has a borderline oceanic/humid subtropical climate (Köppen climate classification: Cfb/Cfa) like most of the eastern Black Sea coast of Turkey, with warm summers and cool winters. Snowfall is quite common between the months of December and March, snowing for a week or two, and it can be heavy once it snows. Rize and the eastern part of the Black Sea coast where it is situated has the highest precipitation in western Asia, with an annual precipitation averaging around 2,500 millimetres (100 in), with heavy rainfall year round and a maximum in late autumn (October to December). The Black Sea coast receives the areatest amount of precipitation in Turkey and is the only region of Turkey that receives high precipitation throughout the year. Because of that do not forget about umbrella and good shoes. The water temperature, as in the whole Turkish Black Sea coast, is always cool, fluctuating between 8 and 20 °C (46 and 68 °F)

throughout the year. If you are going to visit Rize during winter semester you should take some warm clothes too.

b. Time Zone

Turkey is in the Eastern European Time Zone. Eastern European Standard Time (EET) is 2 hours ahead of Greenwich Mean Time (GMT+2).

c. Currency

The Turkish lira (Turkish: Türk lirası) is the currency of Turkey. The Turkish lira is subdivided into 100 kuruş.



The exchange rate is 1 Euro = 3,32Turkish lira (08.08.2016).

d. Banking

All major credit cards (Visa, MasterCard and Euro Card) are accepted in the majority of services and retail outlets. Some outlets may accept Diners Club and American Express cards. Most credit cards can be used in ATMs. Students have the opportunity to conduct transactions in Ziraat Bank located in the main campus. Apart from Ziraat Bank, there are also various ATMs (Automatic Cash Machines) in the main campus.

e. Postal Service

PTT Bank is the cheapest way to send/receive packages or posts. There are also other private postal services (MNG Kargo, Yurtiçi Kargo, etc.)

f. Safety

RTEU is in a secure, low crime area, with living costs that are substantially lower than those on urban areas.

g. Electricity

Turkish power plugs are 2 round pins running at 200V.

h. Telephone If you don't have a GSM mobile phone (cep telefonu, 'pocket phone'), you'll probably use a public pay phone. Look for public phones near post offices, hotels, bus and train stations, shopping areas, and major public squares.

Public phones operated by Türk Telekom have pictograph instructions and operate on either credit cards (Visa, Mastercard, American Express) or on phone cards (telefon kartı, telekart) that you buy from post offices, street kiosks and other places advertising Telekart Satılır (Telekarts for Sale).

It's sometimes easier to use a kontörlü telefon, one with a usage-unit meter attached: you make a call and pay in cash for units used.

These are found at street kiosks and other small businesses.





Be sure to ask the rate per unit before you call. Rates vary: shop around, pay less!

Local (in-city) call: Şehiriçi ara (sheh-HEER-ee-chee ah-rah) Long-distance/Trunk call: Şehirlerarası ara (sheh-heer-LEHR-ah-r ah-suh ah-rah) International call: Milletlerarası ara (mee-leht-LEHR-ahrah-suh ah-rah) (Rates)

Turkey's GSM mobile (cell) phone companies are Turkcell (900 Mhz, the largest), Vodaphone (formerly Telsim (900 Mhz, next largest), and Avea (1800 Mhz, the smallest). Turkcell coverage is the best in Turkey, pretty much everywhere, except for occasional relatively small dead spots in a few remote and/or mountainous areas in the eastern region of the country.

Vodafone, with 22% of the mobile phone customers in Turkey, has fairly good coverage (map) in towns and cities larger than 10,000 in population, but the least complete coverage of the three companies.

Turk Telekom, with 17% of Turkey's mobile phone customers, has extensive coverage of the country (map). You probably won't find significant areas in your travels that have no service.



- l. Theatre

Popular performances are regularly presented in the town as well as on the Campus. The plays on campus are open to students, staff and the public; it is great opportunity to see some popular and innovative shows and maybe even get to see some of the tomorrow's up and coming stars! The

internet. The tickets are not expensive. There are also plenty of opportunities for you to be involved in theatre groups and to perform.





m. Regional attractions and activities

<u>Rize castle</u>

The castle is the last of a chain of Bozuk Castle, Ciha Castle, Pazar Maiden's Castle and Varoş Castle and Zil Castle. Due to geographical structure of Rize, it is not difficult to find a place to see the beautiful view. So the Castle is also one of these places, which serves delicious food, and of course tea!

<u>Rize Museum</u>

In the city centre next to Atatürk's monument there is the 'yellow house'. It is a sample of the 19th Century civil architecture. There is a cafe and restaurant here. Inside of this building you can find a lot of archaeological and ethnographic monuments, official seals and coins. Handwritings are being exhibited there too.

Ziraat Botanical Tea Garden

This place is located only two kilometres away from Rize. You can walk and drink Rize's famous tea and try local desserts. You can notice many tones of green there, breath the clean air and have the best tea in the world. By the way, the view of city of Rize and Black Sea will accompany you.

<u>Ayder</u>

İn this place you can relax in one of many hot springs. The whole of the Kackar range constitutes the beautiful Kackar Dağ ları National Park. For those who like mountain climbing and trekking, this is the best starting point for scaling the Kackar Mountains which summit at 3937 meters, with the glacier lakes. This emerald range is one of the best and the most challenging for climbers in Turkey. Skiing is also very popular activity in Ayder. This place attracts may local and foreign tourists from all over the world during

the year. You can have a great time with your friends if you organise a trip to Ayder for a weekend.

Zil Castle

The castle which is considered to have been constructed at the end of the middle age is in Camlihemsin district, at the western side of Firtina Stream. It is constructed on a rock which an altitude of approximately 100 meters above the water course. Its walls are 1,5-2 meters in thickness. The tower of the castle. which is one of the most interesting historical buildings of the region, is four floored.



City of Trabzon

Major trade centre since times immemorial, and visited by Marco Polo among many others, Trabzon is today one of the major cities of Turkey's northeast coast in the Black Sea. In Trabzon you can also see Aya Sofya Museum. It is a beautiful and picturesque church converted into a mosque and later into a museum that still has stunning frescoes within – just like its namesake in Istanbul. There is a peaceful open-air tea garden on the grounds. You can reach there by any

Dolmuş marked 'Aya Sofya', which departs from the north side of Atatürk Alani Square. The ride takes 5-10 min, and costs about 1.5 TL. This should be one of your essential sights while in Trabzon.


<u>Uzungöl</u>

A lake up in the mountains 99 km from Trabzon, it is surrounded by forests. Uzungöl has an interesting view with the village houses around it. And there are some others small lakes on the on the mountains which are 15-20 km. from Uzungöl. The lake is also placed among convenient tracks for hiking. There are some facilities such as bungalows and some establishments which breed trout. Tourism agencies organize daily tours for the day in the summer.

Sümela Monastery

Today, the monastery's primary function is as a tourist attraction. It overlooks forests and streams, making it extremely popular for its aesthetic attraction as well as for its cultural and religious significance.





<u>Batumi</u>

If you decide to study at our university, you will have an opportunity of visiting Batumi, only 2 hours drive from Rize. As a seaside city on the Black Sea coast Batumi is the capital city of the Autonomus Republic of Ajara in the country of Georgia. Its coastal location and sub-tropical climate make it a popular city of vacationers across the Caucasus. Apart from that its extraordinary buildings, the party capital of the region with a night life to match which increasingly includes big name international DIs on the beach-front

clubs. Expect to party on the beaches with Armenians, Azerbaijanis, Turks and of course Georgians. Daily buses also operate between Batumi and Rize, and the border crossing at Sarpi. Make sure you meet all visa requirements before crossing the border into Georgia.

If you don't like sedentary lifestyle you should try at least one of following activities:

Rafting and canoeing. If you come to Rize you will see many people canoeing on the Black Sea, just opposite of Rize Centre. Rize this is not only the Black Sea. That's why you can try rafting. It is quite popular activity which gives you great fun. Just encourage your friends to go with you. The rafting Centre is only 40 minutes away from centre of Rize. Do you think you are brave enough to do it?

Paintball This kind of sport is new in Rize. Perfect nature and great landscape caused that it is more and more popular. If you haven't tried it before, it will be great experience for you.

Our city is one of the most significant places for trekking. Despite of its short history in Turkey it is one of the most popular nature activities. Local villages and plateaus might give you more than you expect. You can combine many interests such as resting, sporting, photography observing birds and flora in one single activity.

n. Cost of Living and accommodation

Rize is a historical city that is home to many beautiful aspects, with a population of 365.938 people. The cost of living can vary according to personal living standards.

The cost of living for a student ranges between 200 and 400 Euros per month.



Accommodation per person ranges between 100 and 200 Euros. This figure will change according to the location and dimensions of the property, and the number of people sharing. Our university provides limited place for accommodation for Erasmus students. If you are eligible to study in Recep Tayyip Erdogan University please send an email to Erasmus Office to ask about available places.



GETTING TO Recep Tayyip Erdogan University

Rize is the capital city of Rize province in the eastern part of the Black Sea Region of Turkey, on the Black Sea coast. Rize is linked by road with Trabzon (76 km west), Artvin (159 km southeast), Sarp Border Gate on the Georgian border (109 km east), and Erzurum (251 km south).

Rize is carried by airport. There are many direct flight from

Istanbul and Ankara to Rize throughout the year. There is also an international airport only one hour from the main campus on the road in Trabzon. When you arrive at Rize Airport please take a shuttle to city center. You can find it easily on front of Domestic Arrivals Airport. There are many direct flights from this airport to different destinations in Turkiye, Europe and Central Asian countries.

Compared to western European countries, transport is highly cheap in Turkiye. One way flight from Istanbul costs to Rize Airport 50-70 EUR depending on the time of the flight, which takes about one and a half hours.

You can check websites of following airlines Turkish Airlines. It offers regional and also international flights.





If you do not want to arrive to Rize by plain you can choose Interrail. Hope, Iran by highway For more information about the routes and tickets, please visit official websites of Turkish State Railways' and Interrail. You will find there all details about your route. International students can also benefit from bus services every day between Rize and Georgian towns such as Batumi and Tbilisi.

The campus is accessible at any time of the day by bus, taxi or private vehicles from the city and surrounding areas, which takes about ten minutes from the campus to the city centre. Student fares are 25% cheaper.

The port of Rize is the most suitable topographic location to develop among Eastern Black Sea. It is connected to Trabzon, lines.



c. Visa and Residence Permit

<u>Visa</u>

Passports should be valid at least six months longer than the expiry date of the requested visa.

The term "official passports" covers diplomatic, service, special and official passports. Regardless of the visa regime applied towards the citizens of a country,the travel document holders of that country need to obtain visa from Turkish missions beforehand.

If you have a valid visa, you do not need a residence permit up to 90 days. On the other hand, foreigners who shall reside, work or study in Turkey, should register themselves at the nearest local police department upon their arrival in Turkey, regardless of the validity of their visa.

As of April 17, 2013, electronic visa (e-Visa) replaces "sticker visa" which was issued at the border crossings. Applicants just need to log on to www.evisa.gov.tr, provide the requested information, (after the application is approved) make online payment and download their e-Visa. Please note that e-visa is only valid when the purpose of travel is tourism or commerce. Other purposes, such as work and study, require regular visa given by Embassies or Consulates.

Getting a residence permit looks a bit difficult at the beginning. This part will help you how to do it step by step. There are two different residence permit for Erasmus students:

- Erasmus Learning Residence Permit
- Erasmus Internship Residence Permit:

If your stay in Turkey is less than 90 days and your visa allows you to stay here 90 days, you do not need to apply for residence permit.

If you have visa on your passport more than 90 days you still need to apply for residence permit.

Turkish People who live in Europe if they have Turkish ID or Blue Card (Mavi Kart) they do not need to apply for residence permit.

EU citizens have 90 days stay in 180 days. So if you are staying more than 90 days you have to apply for residence permit. It doesn't matter you leave Turkey and come back. Your visa doesn't start again. You can go out of Turkey and come back in your first 90 days. After you spent your 90 days you will be overstayed in the country that's why you need residence permit.

After you passed the customs the police will stamp your passport. After you get the stamp on your passport, your adventure starts!


If you stil reading this article, most probably you need residence permit.

Before doing application just prepare these documents with you in order to have a succesful application:

- Your original passport
- Active Turkish Mobile Number (Better to use your one)
- Valid Health Insurance (you can insure yourself either in your home country or in Turkey. If you do
 this in your country, then you will have it translated. If you do it in Turkey, no translation needed
 and it will be cheaper. The insurance policy should have minimum prices indicated in the list
 below.)
- Detailed Residence Address in Rize (you can have this document from the place owner where you stay)

a. Library




h. Student Clubs

i. Student Health Centre and health insurance

The University **Research Hospital** operates clinics which are maintained by a staff of full time medical doctors and other necessary supportive personnel who specialize in providing the best possible care for both students and

local community. Remember, if you are taking any medicines bring them with you. We strongly recommend you to possess valid international health insurance policy.

j. Transportation

The campus is accessible at any time of the day by minibus, taxi or private vehicles from the city and surrounding areas, which takes about ten minutes from the campus to the city centre. Student fares are 25% cheaper. On-campus accommodation, which houses the majority of undergraduate students, is within walking distance from all faculties and facilities.


